

## NOTICE

### Institute Merit-cum-Means Scholarship

Online applications are invited from the students of IIIT, Kota under Institute's Merit cum Need Based Scholarship for 2016-17 latest by ----- Online application form is available on IIITK Website via Institute ID.

1. The student should produce latest Income certificate with the application form for scholarship which should be submitted before the deadline along with the details of the applicant on a cover sheet available at SW office (2101).
  - a) If parent/guardian is salaried persons, salary based certificate from the employer or salary based slip as on April 2016, should be submitted. A proper income certificate clearly indicating the gross income of both parents, if both are employed, should be submitted along with copy of Form 16, clearly showing the gross income can also be submitted.
  - b) All other applicants should submit an income certificate from the Tahsildar / Mandal Revenue Officer concerned or an affidavit on stamp paper valuing of Rs. 20/- duly countersigned by a **First Class Magistrate / Notary** indicating gross income for the financial year 2016-2017 based on the income of the preceding financial year (2015-2016).
  - c) Pensioners should submit a statement of **bank /post office A/c** from where pension is drawn.
  - d) SW committee on its own can request additional information to verify the claim including personal interview to ascertain facts.

#### 1.0 The Scholarship Scheme & Broad guide line of the Scheme:

- 1.1 Under this Scheme, it is proposed to award (no. of scholarships) ----- scholarships to the gifted or meritorious students whose parental income from all sources is not more than Rs. 5 Lakh per annum from all sources. The scheme would provide reservation for different categories of students as per the norms of State Govt.
- 1.2 Merit Scholarships under the scheme may be awarded to the students on the basis of JEE (main) rank for the first year, and on the basis of CGPA of previous year in the second, third and fourth year provided it is not less than 6.5 CGPA & 6.5 SGPA.
- 1.3 For UG program, the students should have been admitted on the basis of JEE (main) rank list.
- 1.4 The student should have cleared all the examinations of previous semester / year in the first available opportunity except the co-curricular activities course.
- 1.5 The student should not be on disciplinary probation.

- 1.6** Free ship / scholarship would be discontinued if the student fails in any of the subjects in the subsequent ODD semester except in physical education and or his/her CGPA / SGPA in the subsequent ODD semester is less than 6.5.
- 1.7** Free ship / scholarship may be discontinued if the student indulges in any act of indiscipline or violates the code of conduct of the Institute. Regularity in attendance is also implied condition for the continuation of the scholarship.
- 1.8** Unauthorized absence from the Institute will result into forfeiture of scholarship in part or whole for the period of absence or subsequent to such absence.
- 1.9** The student who has not appeared in the ODD semester examination due to shortage of attendance or otherwise will be debarred from further payment of scholarship till he / she clears the semester examination in which he / she has not appeared. No scholarship will be payable for the intervening period.
- 1.10** Unsatisfactory performance of a student during his course of study may result in to discontinuation of scholarship.
- 1.11** The student should not be in receipt of scholarship from any other source.
- 1.12** In case awardee is not able to appear in the examination due to serious illness, one should produce a medical certificate immediately after being fit. The duration of illness should be clearly certified by the Authorized Medical Attendance.
- 1.13** Scholarship shall be deemed to be discontinued with any gap of one semester in studies at any time due to any reason.
- 1.14** The amount of scholarship will be as under:
  - (a)** Waiver of entire /half amount of tuition fee per semester.
  - (b)** Living expenses @ Rs.2500/- per month per semester.
  - (c)** Book grant worth Rs.5000 per semester.

All rules are subject to change from time to time, as and when required and will be binding on all awardees. The decision of the Scholarship Committee will be final.
